The Lincoln County Board of Education prohibits the enrollment of students whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are not legal, full-time residents of Lincoln County unless permission from the Board is granted.

In determining whether a student, for purposes of admissions, is a resident or nonresident student of Lincoln County, the Board of Education authorizes the principal(s) to investigate the residency status of any student attempting to enroll or who is currently enrolled. The principal(s) may request various forms of documentation for proof of legal, full-time residency.

Parents/guardians of nonresident students may request permission from the Board of Education to enroll their child in the school system. The parents/guardian should complete the NonResident Enrollment Request and submit to the principal of the school. The principal will submit the document to the Superintendent for board consideration.

The status of each nonresident student enrolled, excluding children of nonresident personnel, shall be reviewed annually by the principal(s). If the status of the original request has changed, a new request for enrollment must be submitted to the Board for continued enrollment.

Nonresident personnel (excluding temporary or substitute employees) working for the Lincoln County Schools may enroll their children without the payment of tuition.

The Board of Education may charge nonresident students tuition (see policy JBCBA).

All other admission requirements as stated in other Board policies must be met.
